Job Responsibilities

- Successfully complete training, learn how to work within our team and how to become a field surveillance expert.
- Perform on site covert surveillance, mobile surveillance, pedestrian surveillance and undercover surveillance operations as warranted by the case requirements.
- Write detailed narrative reports each day after the surveillance is completed adhering to a specific format in which grammar, punctuation and clarity of content are critical.
- Provide court testimony as required.

Job Requirements

- Must demonstrate ability to write professionally and quickly without exception
- Strong knowledge of Microsoft Word
- Basic knowledge of digital video cameras and related software
- Exceptional critical thinking skills
- Able to take direction from supervisors as well as work alone or in groups
